

***Wynford Chace Tennis
Team Guidelines
6/7/2015***

Philosophy

The tennis courts are owned by the homeowner's (through the homeowner's association) for the homeowner's use and enjoyment. These rules and guidelines have been prepared so Wynford Chace HOA will be consistent with other Cobb County HOA neighborhoods.

League Play

- Captains must be residents of Wynford Chace.
- Captains must ensure the Wynford Chace homeowners are notified and given the opportunity to join the team. This should include, at a minimum, a notice posted at the entrance to the neighborhood and in the message board at the tennis courts. Other means of disseminating this information, such as newsletter article, internet, etc. should be considered.
- Wynford Chace tennis teams will follow all ALTA, USTA, etc. rules and regulations.
- Wynford Chace residents will take priority over non-residents meaning that residents will be afforded the first opportunity to participate in the team.
- Wynford Chace residents that are on a team should be afforded the opportunity to play at least two matches during regular match play.
- Teams may only reserve courts for dates/times of home matches and regular practice sessions.
- Home matches (standard play and makeup matches) supersede any other scheduled playtime.
- Captains must post their schedule for practice, regular home matches, make-up matches, etc. at the tennis courts as soon as the schedule is known.
- Each team may schedule one practice session per week. If two teams play during the same season, the Captains are expected to agree on an acceptable practice schedule.
- Scheduled practice time will continue at the end of each season as long as you are in the playoffs. If and when your team is eliminated the teams scheduled practice time will default to open court time for all homeowners.
- Proper tennis attire is required at all times. Shirts are required and shoes with black soles are not permitted.

- Damage is the responsibility of homeowners involved and must be reported following play to an HOA Board member. If there is damage caused by a non-resident, that player will be held liable to fix the damage.
- Captains must lock the tennis & pool areas and restrooms/clubhouse after league matches.
- During the playing season Captains are responsible for ensuring the clearing the debris off the courts prior-to and after playing the matches. This may entail using a leaf blower or broom to clear pine needles and leaves off the courts. We must insure a safe environment for our residents and guests.
- Captains must ensure that areas used by players and guests are left clean, including cleaning and maintaining the grill, removal of garbage, containers, etc. after the match/practice is over. No glass containers are allowed in the pool area.
- All Association dues must be paid current for a resident to use the tennis facility and participate in Wynford Chace league play.
- Residents are existing homeowners at time of roster submission. (There is no legacy, once a person moves from the subdivision he/she is considered a non-resident).
- A \$25.00 per season participation fee shall be collected by Team Captains before each ALTA and USTA season. Captains should collect all contributions and the total amount paid with one check made payable to “Wynford Chace HOA”. This check will be given to a member of the HOA Board.
- Captains should provide all team members with a copy of this document.
